### **Paper Bag Puppet**

Cut a large oval from brown or tan construction paper. Glue to the bottom of a brown paper lunch bag, as shown. Cut 2 round ears and some fringe for the top of the head. Draw eyes, nose and mouth with a crayon or marker. Cut a long, skinny tail and glue to the back of the bag.
