Craft Box Car Trains

The simplest things can entertain and teach children better than expensive toys and games. Cardboard tubes, boxes, pots and pans, plastic containers--items like these will often keep a young child's attention while a manufactured toy is ignored.

Save shoe boxes or similar containers and work with your child to create a train that will carry her treasures and appeal to her imagination.

Join several boxes by punching holes in the ends and connecting them with heavy yarn or cord. Tie the ends of the yarn around short pieces of cardboard or wood to keep it from pulling out of the holes. Attach a long piece of string or cord to the front of the "engine" so that your child can pull her train. Let her decorate her train with stickers, markers, or pictures from magazines.
